The Shock dropped the first game of a two game west coast road trip, falling 77-70 to the Los Angeles Sparks. The Shock, for the second straight game, went into the half with a lead this time by eight points. In a stellar defensive effort, the Shock held the Sparks to an opponent season-low 26 points in the first half, which was also a season-low in scoring for Los Angeles. Also in Tulsa's defensive effort, they limited the Sparks bench to just eight points on the game. The second half, however, sunk the Shock as they were outscored by 15 points. The Shock were lead by Ivory Latta who scored 16 points and had three assists. Tiffany Jackson and Chante Black each had nine rebounds apiece as the Shock won the rebounding battle 41-36. The Shock also had two players foul out of the game in Scholanda Robinson and Nicole Ohlde. This is the second consecutive game where Ohlde has fouled out. The Shock have lost eight of their last ten games.

Behind Scholanda Robinson's career high 21 points the Tulsa Shock defeated the league-leading Seattle Storm 84-75 at the BOK Center last night. The Shock won their first game at home since June 4 when they defeated Minnesota and handed the Storm just their fourth loss of the season. The Shock are 2-0 when Robinson scores 20 points or more in a game. In her second start for the Shock, Nicole Ohlde led the team with 37 minutes in a game that saw the starters play 162 of the possible 200 minutes in the game. In addition, Ohlde headed a fantastic team defensive effort that limited the Storm to just eight bench points. Tulsa's offensive performance made up for the Shock losing the rebounding battle 38-27. The Shock shot 46% (25/54) from the floor including 50% (9/18) from behind the arc. Additionally, the Shock made 25 of 28 free throws, which included some key foul shots down the stretch to ice the game. The Shock led at halftime for just the eighth time this season and increased their record to 3-2 at the BOK Center when leading after two quarters. A key part of the team success came from Ivory Latta who added 15 points and seven assists in the victory.

The Tulsa Shock scored just nine points in the first quarter and weren't able to get back on track as they fell to the Washington Mystics 87-62 at the Verizon Center on Monday. President Barack Obama was on hand to see his hometown Mystics take a 33-9 lead in the second quarter. Tulsa was able to cut the lead to 19 at the end of the first half, but shot just 27 percent in the first twenty minutes. Tiffany Jackson was the only Shock player to score in double figures, finishing with 14 points and a team high seven rebounds. Washington saw six different players score in double figures.

- At 34-years-old, Marion Jones is the oldest rookie to play in the WNBA this season

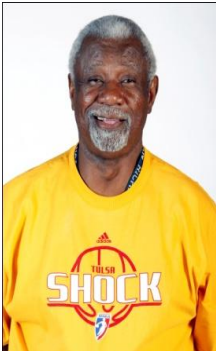

WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.

GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
