<p>Minneapolis, MN- The Shock picked up their first win of the season with Sunday's 94-82 decision, avenging an 80-74 loss to Minnesota on Opening Night (May 15) at the BOK Center. The teams play three more times in the next month, beginning June 4 in Tulsa. They'll wrap up the season series with a home-and-home set on June 18 (Target Center) and 19 (BOK Center). Sunday's loss was Minnesota's third in a row following its season-opening win in Tulsa. A year ago, the Lynx were 3-1 after four games, while the Shock were 1-2 after three (en route to a 1-5 start). Minnesota's next game is on Thursday (May 27) at Connecticut, while Tulsa swings back into action by hosting Phoenix on Tuesday (May 25). Tulsa scored the game's first nine points (including five by Kara Braxton) before Monica Wright's jumper at the 7:30 mark and led by as many as 21 (69-48 on an Amber Holt basket with 3:07 left in the 3rd quarter). The Shock never trailed, with Minnesota pulling to within two on three separate occasions before halftime but getting no closer than nine (79-70 on a Charde Houston three-point play with 4:53 remaining in the contest) after intermission. Chante Black hauled down a career-high 17 rebounds (including eight on the offensive end), equaling the top single-game total in the WNBA this season. Atlanta's Sancho Lyttle also grabbed 17 on Friday (May 21) vs. Connecticut at Philips Arena. Black's total also represents the best single-game mark by a Shock player since Cheryl Ford collected 18 for Detroit vs. New York on July 18, 2007 (OT game) at the Palace of Auburn Hills. Black also registered a career-high and franchise-record six blocks in tonight's contest, tying Atlanta's Alison Bales (May 16 vs. Indiana) for the top single-game effort in the WNBA this season. Tulsa's 30 fast-break points represent the second-highest total in the league this season, behind Atlanta's 31 (May 21 vs. Connecticut). The Shock totaled just 17 points on the break in their first two starts.</p>

<p>Tulsa, OK - The Tulsa Shock were victim to a second straight loss as they fell to the San Antonio Silver Stars 83-74 at the BOK Center on Thursday. Shock center Kara Braxton led the team with 15 points and six rebounds in just 17 minutes of play. Forwards Amber Holt and Scholanda Robinson were also in double figures as they put up 11 and 10 points respectively. Tulsa fell behind quickly as the Silver Stars were on fire in the first five minutes of the game, shooting 70 percent from the field. Edwige Lawson-Wade had nine points in the early going, shooting three-of-three from behind the arc. After falling behind 19-9, the Shock came back with a quick 6-0 run in their favor, capped off by an impressive layup by Marion Jones off the fast break. Every person on the Shock roster saw playing time in the first quarter. The Shock came within one point of the Silver Stars twice in the second quarter before finally taking the lead with 2:32 remaining in the half by way of an old-fashioned three point play, courtesy of Amber Holt. After a back and forth battle the rest of the way, Alexis Hornbuckle hit a critical three pointer with just four seconds left in the half to tie the game. Tulsa found themselves trailing by seven at the end of the third quarter, and could never fully recover as the Silver Stars were able to put them away. Three point shooting played a major role in the game. San Antonio was lights out from behind the arc, shooting 47.4 percent, compared to the Shock's less-than-stellar 20 percent. Tulsa was also outrebounded by a mark of 41-31.</p>

<p>Tulsa, OK – Amidst a sellout crowd showcasing a “yellow out” for their first ever game, the Tulsa Shock dropped their home opener to the Minnesota Lynx 80-74 at the BOK Center on Saturday. Head coach Nolan Richardson’s pastel yellow shirt and pants combo and salmon jacket weren’t enough to help the Shock overcome a 16-point first half deficit. Despite the loss, players were overwhelmed by the support from the home crowd. Plenette Pierson recorded the first points in franchise history off an Alexis Hornbuckle assist. The Shock shot just 25 percent (4-of-16) and trailed by ten after the first quarter. Tulsa outscored the Lynx 24-14 in the second and were able to tie it up when Natasha Lacy hit one of two free throws with just seconds left in the first half. The Shock improved their first quarter shooting woes, going 8-of-19 from the field in the second quarter. Tulsa took their first and only lead of the game early in the second half off of a Shanna Crossley three-pointer. They weren’t able to maintain it, however, as the Lynx went on a 6-0 run over the next two minutes. Tulsa shot just 37 percent from the floor and had 22 turnovers in the loss. Amber Holt came off the bench to lead the team with 16 points on the night. Two Shock players nearly recorded the first double-doubles in franchise history. Starting center Kara Braxton had nine points and nine rebounds on the night, while Chante Black came off the bench to record eight points on 4-of-6 shooting and 10 rebounds.</p>

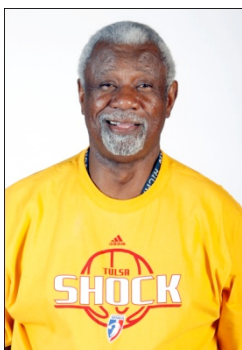

WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
